The SENIOR division was busy competing at the Winter Stampede in Utah, Junior Nationals in Texas and Winter Age Group (WAG) Championships in Riverside to tie up December. The Senior Division represented the Nadadores incredibly well throughout the entire month and has so much to be proud of. As we move out of winter training, we're full speed ahead with eyes on Sectionals in Carlsbad and the TYR Pro Series in Ft. Lauderdale, FL in March.

WINTER MEET HIGHLIGHTS

The Winter Stampede in St. George, UT saw over 70 Lifetime Best Times with multiple podium winners and top 24 swims. The MVN event winners were Jack Samuels in the 200 IM and 100 Breastroke. Kenna Stinson also won the 200 Backstroke.

MVN finished Western JR Nationals with a 2nd place women's team finish with TWO highlight 1st place relay finishes, new team records and SCS records in the 200 Medley Relay (O'Dell, Phillips, Kozan and Salvino) and the 200 Freestyle Relay (Salvino, Kozan, Aquino and O'Dell). The meet also produced 2nd place finishes in the other women relays with new team records and standout individual races that broke team records and got MVN athletes on the podium multiple times!

Not to be missed, the 13/14 and SR divisions also made a tremendous showing at WAGs in Riverside. <u>4 NEW TEAM RECORDS</u> were broken: 13/14 Division's Nolan Baker's 100 SCY Back, the boys 13/14 200 SCY FREE Relay (Baker, Yeo, Wang, Nguyen), 200 Medley Relay (Nguyen,







Weiland, Yeo, Baker) and the 400 Medley (Nguyen, Weiland, Yeo, Baker). Nadadores stood as a relay team or as individuals atop the podium 33 times in the 13/14 and SR divisions at WAGs.

CHRIS VONK INVITATIONIAL

The annual Chris Vonk Diving Invitational was held December 2–4. Nearly 130 divers participated and our Nadadores divers, at all levels, had 105 personal best performances! The coaching staff was most impressed with how well our athletes competed. Our step back to build a strong foundation of basic skills for long-term success was evident from the results, despite competing against others with more difficult dives. Great job Nadadores and keep up the good work!

FINA JUNIOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Nadadores diving program was represented by 3 athletes at the Junior World Championships in Montreal, Canada last month.

We are thrilled to announce that we have a newly crowned Junior World Championship in <u>ANNA LEMKIN</u> who bested every other diver in the world and won the 14–15 Girls 3m competition. In addition to this, Anna was a bronze medalist in the 14-15 Girls Platform competition.

<u>ARI DRAKE</u> represented the Philippines in the 16–18 Girls 1m and 3m competition. Ari did extremely well and represented the program and her country with pride!

<u>TOMMY MATHEIS</u> participated in the first ever Junior World High Diving Championships and placed 6th place in the world in his age group. He performed well and made all of us proud back at home!





DIVE

LESSONS, GYM 2 DIVE AND HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Our lesson divers are fully engaged in the program and getting more comfortable and confident on dryland and in the water. Many have learned new skills and are excited with their progress. Some have even expressed how much fun it is to train on the dry boards, and most are becoming accustomed to diving in the winter months.

Our Gym 2 Dive program is growing, and gymnasts are busy picking up new diving skills on the boards. Most agree it's the simple skills that are harder to master then those that transfer (like multiple twisters) from the gym to dive. These athletes are now learning more dives on 3 meter springboard and 5 meter platform and most have gained the confidence to jump from 10 meter.

High School divers have been training in the evenings with most participating 2–3 days per week. Our more experienced HS divers have welcomed, helped and included the newer members. They also enjoy demonstrating skills and encouraging teammates to try new skills. High School divers have focused on basics in the past week and the results are increased rip entries, more confidence attempting new skills and an overall polished look to their dives. 8 of the 16 High School divers even competed in the Chris Vonk meet and most are becoming more confident on platform and 3 meter.

Staff Corner: Executive Director, Michele Mitchell



In 2021 the Board of Directors of the Mission Viejo Nadadores Foundation hired Michele Mitchell to be their first Executive Director. Her new role came after completing 4 years as the Head Diving Coach at the newly renovated Marguerite Aquatics Complex.

A former Olympian for the Nadadores, Mitchell arrived back in Mission Viejo for her legacy job having retired from the University of Arizona after 22 years: 17 as Head Diving Coach and 5 years working in Athletic



Administration. During her tenure as the Nadadores head coach, she expanded the diving program from less than 60 divers to 200+, doubled the

budget, significantly increased fundraising, and recruited numerous events, including the first FINA Grand Prix event held in US in 30 years. Her divers won both individual national titles, and the national championship team title, the first one in 18 years.

Her personal diving accomplishments speak for themselves. Mitchell is a two-time Olympic Silver medalist on the 10-meter platform (1984 & 1988), World FINA Cup and Pan Am gold medalist and a 9x national champion among many other accolades.

She holds a Ph.D. in Educational Psychology and an M.A. in Sports Administration. She has served as Chair of the Board of Directors of USA Diving along with many other positions in the organization and Chair of the NCAA Swim and Dive Rules committee. She was a member of the University of Arizona Hall of Fame committee as well as the Gender Equity committee. She has served as a speaker for numerous corporations and has an extensive background in television and radio broadcasting – including the 1992 and 1996 Olympic Games.

As Executive Director, Mitchell has been tasked with expanding the Nadadores aquatics programs, rebranding the team, enhancing fundraising and positioning both the Nadadores and City of



Mission Viejo for success leading up to the LA 2028 Games.

She is married to Tim Sutton, a sports television director, and has two children: Ariana, a Captain in the Army, and Dakota, a nuclear technician in the Navy. In her spare time, she enjoys jet skiing, riding bikes and keeping in touch with friends from around the world.
