YOUR VOTE MATTERS!

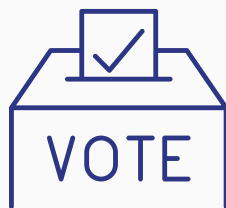

Due to our late start in the water, most of our programs will be shooting for the Chris Vonk Invitational that we host as our first competition December 2-4, 2022.

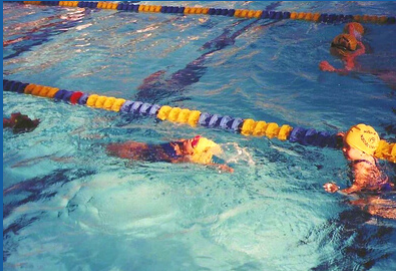
DIVE COMMITTEE
